

Art Dubai returns to Madinat Jumeirah next week as part of Dubai Art Week

The massive fair will showcase works from 41 countries across four galleries



It's that time of year again, when we don our berets, stroke our (often imaginary) facial hair and consider the [artworks](#) in our midst.

That's right – Dubai Art Week is approaching, and at the very epicentre of it all is Art Dubai, a three-day annual event at Madinat Jumeirah from Wednesday March 20 until Saturday March 23.

The massive art fair showcases 41 countries across four galleries, with every [art](#) form including painting, drawing, sculpture, installations and photography.

The Contemporary section features the established and the emerging with pieces from the likes of Addis Fine Art in London, Aicon Art in New York, Galerie Kornfeld in Berlin and The Third Line from right here in Dubai.

The Modern section of the fair presents works from the Middle East, South Asia and Africa that have been influential throughout the 20th century and is overseen by a committee of leading academics and curators including Dr. Iftikhar Dadi, Catherine David, Vali Mahlouji and Dr. Nada Shabout.

The brand-new Bawawaba section will focus on conceptual works including videos, murals and installations to give viewers a feel of the Global South while the Residents section (with 12 exhibiting galleries) will feature a dialogue between the UAE and Latin America.
